Part 1**Fairmount Park****§16-101. Hours.**

In order to regulate the use of the facilities of Fairmount Park and Nitchkey Field within the Borough of Red Lion, and to protect persons and property therein, no person shall be permitted to enter or remain in Fairmount Park or Nitchkey Field, including parking areas, between the hours of sunset and sunrise. Exceptions to this prohibition may be authorized in writing by the Mayor of Red Lion or the Chief of the York Regional Police Department.

§16-102. Exception to Park Closing Time.

This prohibition shall not apply to persons lawfully present for the use of the facilities of the Youth Center and Community Building; provided, that such access to the park be limited to the parking lot located in the park between the water tank and the community building, the parking lot facing South Charles Street and the area lying between the Community Building and Fairview Street, as shown on a plan attached hereto.

§16-103. Violations and Penalties.

Any person who shall violate any provision of this Part, upon conviction thereof, shall be sentenced to a fine of not more than \$1,000 plus costs and, in default of payment of said fine and costs, to a term of imprisonment not to exceed 30 days. Each day that a violation of this Part continues or each Section of this Part which shall be found to have been violated shall constitute a separate offense.
