

ORDINANCE NO. 2010- 09-01

AN ORDINANCE OF RED LION BOROUGH, YORK COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA, AMENDING CHAPTER 7 (FIRE PREVENTION AND FIRE PROTECTION) TO PROVIDE FOR INSPECTION OF SMOKE DETECTORS BY CODE ENFORCEMENT OFFICER

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ENACTED AND ORDAINED by the Borough Council of Red Lion Borough, York County, Pennsylvania, as follows:

SECTION 1. Chapter 7 (Fire Prevention and Fire Protection), Part 3 (Smoke Detectors) of the Red Lion Borough Code of Ordinances shall be revised by eliminating existing Section 7-302 and replacing it in its entirety with the following provision:

Section 7-302. Location within Dwelling Units

The smoke detector shall always be installed on ceilings, but never closer than 12 inches from corners of interior walls. At least one smoke detector shall be installed in each dwelling unit and should be installed at the top of stairways or at a point between sleeping areas and potential fire sources. In addition, in multi-family dwellings, smoke detectors shall be installed in all common hall areas. In the event that said common hall area is more than 20 feet in length, one smoke detector shall be required for every 20 feet or portion thereof of common hall area. A fire extinguisher for every floor is required in multi-family dwellings.

SECTION 2. Chapter 7 (Fire Prevention and Fire Protection), Part 3 (Smoke Detectors) of the Red Lion Borough Code of Ordinances shall be revised by eliminating existing Section 7-304 and replacing it in its entirety with the following provision:

Section 7-304. Inspecting and Testing.


The Code Enforcement Officer is hereby authorized and empowered to inspect each smoke detector installed under the terms of this Part within a dwelling unit annually, or upon the occurrence of a fire within the leased or rented dwelling unit, to determine the capability of the smoke detector to fulfill the requirements of this Part.

SECTION 3. This Ordinance shall be effective five (5) days after adoption.

SECTION 4. Any Ordinance conflicting or inconsistent with this Ordinance is repealed to the extent of such conflict or inconsistency.





ORDINANCE NO. 2010- 10-02

AN ORDINANCE OF RED LION BOROUGH, YORK COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA,
AMENDING CHAPTER 21 (STREETS AND SIDEWALKS) TO LIMIT SKATEBOARDING
AND ROLLERBLADING

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ENACTED AND ORDAINED by the Borough Council of Red Lion Borough, York County, Pennsylvania, as follows:

SECTION 1. Chapter 21 (Streets and Sidewalks) of the Red Lion Borough Code of Ordinances shall be amended to include the addition of Part 5:

Part 5 Skateboarding and Rollerblading

Section 21-501. Skateboarding and rollerblading prohibited.

A. It shall be unlawful for any person to use, ride, propel or otherwise operate or engage in skateboarding or rollerblading at any time on any public street, alley or sidewalk in the Borough of Red Lion.

B. A skateboard is defined as a device propelled by the rider consisting of material or portion of material approximately two feet long with wheels attached to the underside which is commonly ridden on and propelled by an individual in a standing or crouching position.

C. A rollerblade is defined as a device which is attached to an individual's feet which has wheels attached in a column along the underside which are propelled by the individual and which are intended primarily for skating on concrete, macadam or hard floors.

Section 21-502. Violations and penalties.

Any person who shall violate any provision of this part shall, upon conviction before a District Justice, be sentenced to pay a fine of not more than \$600, plus costs, and, in default of said fine and costs, to a term of imprisonment not to exceed 30 days.

SECTION 2. This Ordinance shall be effective five (5) days after adoption.

SECTION 3. Any Ordinance conflicting or inconsistent with this Ordinance is repealed to the extent of such conflict or inconsistency.





AN ORDINANCE OF RED LION BOROUGH, YORK COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA,
AMENDING CHAPTER 15 (MOTOR VEHICLES AND TRAFFIC) PART 11
(SKATEBOARDING AND ROLLERBLADING) TO IMPOSE A PENALTY

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ENACTED AND ORDAINED by the Borough Council of Red Lion Borough, York County, Pennsylvania, as follows:

SECTION 1. Chapter 15 (Motor Vehicles and Traffic) Part 11 (Skateboarding and Rollerblading) of the Red Lion Borough Code of Ordinances shall be amended to include the following Section:

Section 15-1102. Violations and penalties.

Any person who shall violate any provision of this part shall, upon conviction before a District Justice, be sentenced to pay a fine of not more than \$600, plus costs, and, in default of said fine and costs, to a term of imprisonment not to exceed 30 days.

SECTION 2. This Ordinance shall be effective five (5) days after adoption.

SECTION 3. Any Ordinance conflicting or inconsistent with this Ordinance is repealed to the extent of such conflict or inconsistency.





ORDINANCE NO. 2010-12-04

AN ORDINANCE OF RED LION BOROUGH, YORK COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA,
AMENDING CHAPTER 1 (ADMINISTRATION AND GOVERNMENT) PART 3
(COMMISSIONS AND BOARDS) TO INCREASE THE NUMBER OF PLANNING
COMMISSION MEMBERS

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ENACTED AND ORDAINED by the Borough Council of Red Lion Borough, York County, Pennsylvania, as follows:

SECTION 1. Chapter 1 (Administration and Government) Part 3 (Commissions and Boards) A. Planning Commission of the Red Lion Borough Code of Ordinances shall be amended as follows:

Section 1-301. Commission Created.

A Borough Planning Commission, to be comprised of seven members, appointed as provided by law, is hereby created in and for the Borough of Red Lion. Said Borough Planning Commission shall perform all the duties and may exercise all the powers conferred by law upon Borough planning agencies, provided that the Borough Planning Commission previously created in and for said Borough shall constitute the Planning Commission hereby created, and nothing herein shall affect the tenure of any member of said existing Planning Commission, but any vacancy occurring therein shall be filled in the manner and for the term provide in the law governing Borough Planning Commissions in effect at the time of the occurrence of such vacancy.


SECTION 2. This Ordinance shall be effective five (5) days after adoption.




