5. Appointments and Reappointments

Ms. Barley made a motion to reappoint Scott Kopp to the vacancy board, Mr. Holloway seconded. All in favor; motion carried.

Ms. Barley made a motion to reappoint Craley Law firm to the 2026 calendar year, Mr. Minnich seconded. All in favor, motion carried.

Ms. Barley made a motion to reappoint CS Davidson as engineer for the 2026 calendar year; Mr. Musso seconded the motion. Mr. Klinedinst opposed, motion carried.

Mr. Minnich made the motion to reappoint Kelly Henshaw to the Red Lion Municipal Authority; Mr. Musso seconded the motion. All in favor, motion carried.

Ms. Barley made a motion to appoint Ms. Poole as the representative for the York Area Earned Income Tax Bureau and Ms. Runkle as the alternate. Mr. Musso seconded the motion, all in favor; motion carried.

Mr. Heister made a motion to approve Resolution 2026-1 to appoint Bruce G. Stegman to Zoning Hearing Board, Ms. Barley seconded. All in favor; motion carried.

Ms. Barley made a motion to approve Resolution 2026-2 to appoint Stephanie Weaver as Alternate to Zoning Hearing Board, Mr. Minnich seconded the motion. Mr. Klinedinst opposed due to him thinking she is not committed to the position, motion carried.

Mr. Heister made a motion to reappoint Muriel Slenker to the Economic Development Commission, Ms. Phillips seconded the motion. All in favor; motion carried. Mr. Klinedinst questioned how they have a quorum with only 4 members and Mr. Heister noted that it is the goal for 2026 to get more involvement in Economic Development.

Mr. Heister made a motion to reappoint Becky Gibney and Frank Burke to the recreation Committee; Ms. Barley seconded the motion. All in favor; motion carried.

Ms. Barley made the motion to reappoint Hamilton & Musser as the auditors for the 2025 audit to be completed. Ms. Phillips seconded, all in favor; motion carried.
