1. The meeting was called to order @ 7:00 p.m. by Mayor Hughes. Mayor Hughes stated he will have office hours on Tuesday evenings from 6 to 8pm. He will be active in committees and plans an awards night in the future.
2. A moment of silence was observed followed by the pledge to the flag
3. Mayor Hughes administered the Oath of Office to elected council members Chris Minnich, Antonino Musso, Cynthia Barley and Stephanie Weaver. Mayor Hughes administered the Oath of Office to Michael Zelger as Tax Collector.
4. **Reorganization of Council** – conducted by Mayor Hughes:

 - b. Vice President– Mr. Horne nominated Dennis Klinedinst for the position; seconded by Ms. Weaver. Roll call vote was taken. Mr. Horne, Mr. Klinedinst and Ms. Weaver voted in favor. Mrs. Barley, Mrs. Frutiger, Mr. Minnich and Mr. Musso were opposed. Motion did not pass.
Mr. Musso made a motion to nominate Cindy Barley for vice president. Mrs. Frutiger seconded it. Roll call vote was taken. All were in favor.
 - c. President Pro Tem - Mr. Musso nominated Christina Frutiger for the position; seconded by Mrs. Barley. Roll call vote was taken. All were in favor.
5. At this time the meeting was turned over to the new president.

 - d. Assistant Treasurer – Mrs. Barley made the motion to appoint Dianne Price; seconded by Mrs. Frutiger. All were in favor
 - e. Code Enforcement – Mrs. Barley made the motion to appoint Daniel Shaw; seconded by Mrs. Frutiger. All were in favor.
7. **Vacancy Board** – Mr. Klinedinst made the motion to appoint Ann Reichard to the position; seconded by Mrs. Barley. All were in favor
 8. **Solicitor** – Mrs. Frutiger made the motion to appoint Mike Craley, Esquire, to the position; seconded by Mrs. Barley. Mr. Horne opposed the motion. Motion passed.
 9. **Zoning Solicitor** – Mrs. Barley made the motion to appoint Gavin Markey, Esquire, to the position; seconded by Mrs. Frutiger. All were in favor.
 10. **Signatures on Checks** – Mrs. Barley made the motion to authorize all council members to sign the checks; Mrs. Frutiger seconded. Mr. Horne opposed the motion. Motion passed
 11. **Auditors** – Mrs. Price was asked to get proposals for auditors
 12. **Engineer** – Mrs. Frutiger made the motion to appoint CS Davidson to the position; seconded by Mrs. Barley. Mr. Horne, Mr. Klinedinst and Ms. Weaver opposed. Motion passed.
 13. Solicitor Craley explained about the veto by former Mayor Kopp of Ordinance 2017-12-9. Council can take a vote to try to override on Monday the 8th but it requires 5 votes to override a veto. The council voted to authorize the solicitor to draft a new ordinance with a slight modification for action at a special meet on Monday, January 15, 2018 at 6:30 pm. Motion was made by Mrs. Frutiger, seconded by Mrs. Barley. Mr. Horne, Mr. Klinedinst and Ms. Weaver opposed the motion. Motion carried.

Meeting was adjourned at 7:30 pm.
